



# Coyote Cone Six Glazes

## Layering Shino colors over Black

Want to get something incredible out of your electric kiln?

Coyote Shino glazes are the ideal match of beauty and reliability. Stable, easy to apply, and very user friendly, the Shinos provide gorgeous effects and amazing variety, similar to gas fired glazes. They are excellent when used over texture or on top of other glazes. The Shinos are easy to use, are not runny, and with the exception of Green Shino (044), they are food safe.

All of the layered glazes on this page are the indicated color over Coyote Black MBG-002. The cups shown are made of a speckled buff colored clay, bisque fired to cone 06, but these glazes work well and look great on any cone 5-6 clay.

For brushing, apply 3 coats of Black. Allow to dry, then apply 2 to 3 coats of the Shino color. For best results alternate the direction of your brushstrokes; the first coat side to side, next coat up and down. The glazes can also be applied by dipping, one coat of each color.
