Luehrsen taught 3D design at Mesa Community College for 18 years. The Auckland Institute and Museum in New Zealand, the ASU Art Museum's Ceramics Research Center, the West Valley Art Museum, the Cities of Phoenix, Tempe, Peoria, Chandler, and Prescott Valley, the Kamm Teapot Foundation, and other collections hold her work.

Use hand built vessel forms as inspiration for innovative functional or non-functional sculpture. Vessel forms like cups, teapots, pitchers, jars, and vases provide an interesting and comfortable starting point for sculptural forms. Maybe your sculpture is also functional or maybe you'll create decorative or idea pieces. You'll have an opportunity to explore and discover new and unique forms to add to your own visual vocabulary. Possibilities will abound!

Marjon Ceramics has a well-equipped classroom with a slab roller and other tools. Luehrsen will provide a few tools for participants to use. Marjon will fire your sculptures for the standard firing fee. Clay is included!
