Detailed workshop description.

In this 2 day workshop students will learn to handbuild both simple and complex forms using easy to learn techniques. I most frequently use the pinch method of construction as I have a lot of control over the form as I am adding small amounts of clay at a time.



The first day we will start making forms and there will be a demonstration and slide show presentation. On the second day we will finish all the forms and explore some finishes.

Please bring your clay tools, the clay will be provided. Marjons has a very well equipped classroom so no need to bring buckets, banding wheels or rolling pins. There will be a lunch break on both days so bring snacks and beverages.
