In this hands-on workshop, participants will stretch their imagination to create expressive sculptures and figurative vessels depicting realistic or whimsical people and animals. Jane will discuss basic anatomy and proportions and will demonstrate slab building and modeling sculpture techniques.

Tools to bring: Basic pottery tools plus small wood modeling tools about 1/4" wide, rolling pin, serrated flexible metal rib, small knife, fork, small acrylic paint brush for smoothing, images as references if desired. Marjons has a well equipped classroom with banding wheels, water buckets, extruders and slab roller.
