components, or a mix of the two

decorate your teapot or make teacups.

There is a one-hour lunch break (lunch is not provided), then we will work on assembly and finishing until 3:00 p.m. Please bring your own tools, or purchase them before class. If you choose the throw, you must have wheel experience, this is an intermediate class and I will not be teaching basics (how to center, pull a wall, etc.).
